

c-spine roll out

any check marks before highlighted items indicates need for immobilization

mechanism of minor nature

ground level fall
minor to no damage in mva w/ seat belt

new onset change in level of consciousness
or loss of consciousness during event

head injury w/ moderate or > facial injuries
facial fractures / lacerations 4" or greater

direct complaints of neurological injury
cervical, thoracic, or lumbar midline pain
new onset extremity weakness or paralysis
extremity numbness, tingling, burning or
paresthesia from trauma

positive physical findings
spinal pain on palpation
deformity to spinal column
moderate to significant trauma over spinal column

**pain or reduced range of motion on flexion
extension, or lateral rotation of neck**

mechanism of moderate nature

falls > 3 feet < 6 feet
vehicle damage > 6" and < 12" exterior damage

age <12 or > 65

> 1 isolated distal extremity injury or fracture

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**pain or reduced range of motion on flexion
extension, or lateral rotation of neck**

mechanism of severe nature

any trauma of significant mechanism or injury

- * windshield / steering wheel damage from patient impact
 - * rollover w/ ejection and / or other sustained injuries
 - * gunshot to head/neck/chest/abdomen
 - * falls >10 feet
- others-see county trauma triage guidelines
